Summary of rules

- Scarecrows to be erected within the Parish boundary of Wickham Bishops - visible from public road or footpath
- Entries welcomed from residents and local groups, associations, clubs and businesses (including schools, nurseries and playgroups)
- Scarecrows on display from 5th – 13th June 2021
- Some straw is to be included in the construction and be visible at the neck and/or wrists and/or ankles.
- To be included the scarecrow trail map, please register by 29th May
- To be included in the judging, send a photograph of the scarecrow once in place to wbscarecrowweek@gmail.com by 10th June
- Judging on 11th and 12th June. Winners announced on 13th June.

Let your imagination run wild – your scarecrow will be judged on:

- The Theme ‘Heroes or Villains’ or how it reflects the club, organisation or business that has constructed it. How environmentally friendly it is: Recycled materials, old clothes, hats, newspapers & of course don’t forget the STRAW!
- Construction & functionality: The quality of the build & will it attract or scare crows?
- *However there is no judging criteria for the People’s Choice winner – as the scarecrow that gets the popular vote - who knows what criteria they might judge the scarecrow on!*
- By entering the event you confirm acceptance of the rules.
