The Chairman noted that the MDC Street Scene and Enforcement Officer had renewed a warning sign in School Road following reports of instances of dog waste being left in the area. The area will now be monitored by the Officer.

15/210 | Clerk's Report

The Clerk reported that the month had been fairly busy, with planning issues and drafting the budget for 2016-17. The Clerk also completed her CiLCA portfolio in October and submitted it to Essex County Council for review prior to final submission for marking.

It was reported that the Parish Council's registration with the Information Commissioner's Office has been renewed, at a cost of £35.

The Clerk reminded Councillors that the training course will be on 17thNovember in the Village Hall from 10am to 12.30pm.

15/211 | Public Forum

A member of the public spoke in support of planning application *HOUSE/MAL/15/00975* Thornridge Mope Lane.

Four members of the public spoke against proposals to build 51 houses behind Church Road.

15/212 | Church Road Development

The Chairman stated that the development at Snows Corner fulfilled the identified affordable housing need in Wickham Bishops and read out the following statement from MDC clarifying the status of sites identified on the Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA):

"The identification of sites in the SHLAA should not be taken as an intention to allocate these sites for housing or that planning permission will be granted."

It was noted that no planning application had been submitted and the Chairman explained to the meeting the actions that the Parish Council can take once an application is received.

15/214 An Update on the Snows Corner Development and Street Naming

Cllr Johnson read out a statement from the Chairman of the Planning Committee Cllr Barry Sayers reporting the progress of the development. The properties currently under construction are the open market homes. The affordable homes are being handled by the English Rural Housing Association and are expected to commence in the new year. The allocation of these dwellings will be arranged by MDC's Housing Department and will be offered to qualifying parishioners of Wickham Bishops.

An exhibition will be held around the end of January in the village hall with support from MDC, the developers of the affordable homes and the selling agents of the open market homes.

It was observed that there had been large amounts of mud on Witham Road coming from the construction site.

Action: the Clerk to request the mud be cleaned regularly.
