	No letters of objection had been received.  The site lies along a narrow country lane with rural aspect and sporadic development. Councillors noted that the area is becoming more urbanised and several nearby dwellings have brick-built walls and piers with metal gates.  It was felt that the height of the walls nearest to the road gave a dominant appearance and the height was reported to exceed that of other properties' walls along the lane. The Planning Committee felt that the height would adversely affect the street-scene, contrary to Submission LDP Policies D1 – Design Quality and Built Environment and S8 – Settlement Boundaries and the Countryside and to Adopted RLP Policies CC6 – Landscape Protection, CC7 – Special Landscape Areas, BE1 – Design of New Development and Landscaping and S2 – Development Outside Development Boundaries.
